Kansas City Power & Light Company is represented by Daniel C. Gibb (“Mr. Gibb”) of SNR Denton. On July 22, 2011, Mr. Gibb filed Motion to Withdraw. He states that he is moving out of Missouri, and therefore requests leave of the Commission to withdraw.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(6) allows attorneys to withdraw from representation before the Commission only by leave of the Commission. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows ten days to respond to pleadings and motions, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. No party responds to Mr. Gibb’s motion. The Commission will grant Mr. Gibb leave to withdraw.

1. The Motion to Withdraw is granted, and Daniel C. Gibb is granted leave of the Commission to withdraw his appearance in this case.
