We also didn't discuss the authentication surrounding www2.ameren.com. In fact, it was the quite opposite when Mr. Felber made that to the attention of the Commission and Ameren. The suspicion of www2.ameren.com was raised as a grounds for re-hearing, however, it was never discussed at any time, by the Commission, or during the hearing in EC-2023-0395 or any matter within EC-2023-0395.

While Mr. Felber has clearly filed his stance and surrounding Exhibits to suffice proof that www2.ameren.com isn't an email address and wouldn't send. Staff of the Commission and Ameren Missouri have yet to file a response.

Besides, the document raises clear issues within Ameren to show they have a altering problem, modifying problem, forgery problem and counterfeit problem.

Settlement agreements, payment agreements and payment plans don't come from or send from www2.ameren.com, as that is a web hosting domain and lacks the @ symbol to send.

Settlement agreements, payment agreements and payment plans prior to November of 2023 came from the email address of DoNotReply@ameren.com. November 2023 through the current year, their settlement agreements, payment agreements and payment plans come from do-not-reply@alerts.ameren.com.

Anything outside of those two email address that are the mutually agreed settlement agreement, payment agreement and payment plan notification agreements, would be a counterfeit, forged or altered non-binding agreement.

Please admit that www2.ameren.com is NOT an email address, and wouldn't send?
