1. On March 27, 2024, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Transfer of Assets and Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* (“*Order*”) in this case. The *Order*, among other things, requires Confluence Rivers to “. . . file notice in this case outlining completion of the above-recommended training, customer communications, notifications, and billing for Lake Sherwood within 10 days after such communications and notifications[.]” (*Order*, p. 6, para. 2.n.).


