# **ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE**

On December 11, 2024, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) for 345 kV transmission lines across a portion of North Central Missouri and for authority to transfer an ownership interest in a portion of the transmission lines to the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission d/b/a Missouri Electric Commission (MEC).

The Commission directed notice and set a deadline for applications to intervene of January 10, 2025. The Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. (MISO), MEC, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri, Clean Grid Alliance, and Sierra Club all filed timely applications to intervene. More than ten days have passed since the applications were filed and no one has objected to their applications.<sup>1</sup> After considering the unopposed applications to intervene, the Commission finds that MISO, MEC, Renew Missouri, Clean Grid Alliance, and Sierra Club have interests that are different from that of the general public and allowing them to intervene will serve the public interest.

Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

# THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applications to intervene of the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. (MISO), the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission d/b/a Missouri Electric Commission (MEC), Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri, Clean Grid Alliance, and Sierra Club are granted.

2. This order is effective when issued.
