## ORDER SCHEDULING A WORKSHOP MEETING AND DIRECTING RESPONSE

The Commission has established this working case to consider the potential impacts of current and future Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) rules on the reliability and cost of the electric generation plant operated by Missouri's electric utilities. On June 30, 2014, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to schedule a workshop meeting to address the cost of compliance with the EPA's recently published proposed state-specific rate-based goals for carbon dioxide emissions for existing fossil fuel-fired electric generating units. Staff also asks the Commission to direct the electric utilities to make presentations at the workshop meeting to explain how they are responding to the proposed EPA regulations.

The Commission will schedule the workshop meeting that Staff has requested.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A workshop meeting is scheduled for Monday, August 18, 2014, starting at 10:00 a.m. and continuing until approximately 3:00 p.m. The workshop meeting will be held

in the Ballroom (Conference Room 450) of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.

Each of Missouri's investor-owned electric utilities Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, The Empire District Electric Company, and Kansas City Power & Light Company / KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall make presentations at the meeting to explain how they are responding to the EPA's proposed regulation.
- 3. Any other stakeholder that wishes to make a presentation at the meeting is invited to do so. Any stakeholder wishing to make a presentation must contact Natelle Dietrich, Director, Utility Operations before the meeting to arrange their presentation.
