# NOTICE CONCERNING STATUTES, REGULATIONS, AND TARIFFS RELEVANT TO THE ISSUE IDENTIFIED BY PARTIES

Issue Date: January 22, 2020

On September 30, 2019, Patricia Sue Stinnett (Complainant) filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) against Kansas City Power & Light Company (the Company).<sup>1</sup> She alleged the Company had charged her for a nonexisting light pole for ten years following notice on April 20, 2009 that the light pole had been destroyed in a fire. The Company has filed an answer and motion to dismiss. The Commission Staff has filed a report. It appears from the pleadings and report that there is no dispute that as alleged, the Company did charge for a non-existing light pole for ten years. On December 27, 2020, the Commission issued its Procedural Schedule Order requiring the parties to file an Issues list by January 17, 2020. On January 16, 2020, the

parties filed a List of Issues. They identified one issue: "Did the Company take any actions that constitute a violation of any law, regulation, Commission Order, or Evergy Missouri West tariff?"

The Commission gives notice that at the hearing it will require Commission Staff to specifically identify every statute, Commission regulation, and Company tariff which the Commission should consider in resolving the issue identified by the parties.
