The Commission opened this file on May 28, 2020, as a working case to assist its Staff in its consideration of amendments to the Commission's rule on electric renewable energy standard requirements found at 20 CSR 4240-20.100. On May 26, 2021, Staff filed a draft amendment to the rule and asked the Commission to direct interested stakeholders to submit comments about the draft rule amendment. The Commission did so in an order issued on June 2, 2021, directing stakeholders to respond by July 2, 2021.

On June 4, 2021, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro, Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West, and The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty filed a joint request for more time to respond to the draft amendment submitted by Staff. The joint request asks that stakeholders be allowed until July 30, 2021, to file their responses and represents that Staff does not object to that extension. The Commission will grant the joint request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any stakeholder wishing to file comments regarding the draft rule amendment filed by Staff on May 26, 2021, shall do so no later than July 30, 2021.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
