**FINDING OF NECESSITY AND ORDER DIRECTING THAT PROPOSED  
RESCISSIONS BE FILED FOR PUBLICATION**

The Commission has undertaken this rulemaking to rescind its Chapter 3 procedural rules as those rules have been incorporated into revised Chapter 20 substantive rules regarding demand-side programs and demand-side program investment mechanisms as they relate to the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act. The Commission finds that the rescission is necessary to protect the public interest and to carry out the purposes of the statute that granted the Commission authority to regulate in this area.

The Commission has discussed this amendment with interested stakeholders and will seek further comments during the rulemaking process.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Secretary of the Commission shall file the rescissions with the Secretary of State for publication in the Missouri Register as proposed rescissions.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
