

At a session of the Public Service Commission held at its office in Jefferson City on the 12th day of September, 2018.

On September 5, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL&L) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) jointly filed an application for rehearing and request for stay, contending the rule is contrary to law. Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2016,

indicates the Commission may grant rehearing if, “in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear.” In the judgment of the Commission, KCP&L and GMO have not demonstrated sufficient reason to grant rehearing. That application will be denied.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application for Rehearing and Request for Stay filed by Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company is denied.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
