**ORDER DIRECTING THE PARTIES TO SUBMIT A NEW PROPOSED
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On January 22, 2025, the parties submitted a joint proposed procedural schedule for the Commission’s consideration. That proposed schedule contemplated the Commission holding a three-day evidentiary hearing from June 3, 2025, through June 5, 2025. The Commission has already reserved those dates for local public hearings in File No.GR-2025-0107, a general rate case.

The Commission has the following conflicts for the months of June and July:

- June 2-5, 2025 – Local public hearings in GR-2025-0107
- June 9-20, 2025 – Evidentiary hearing in GR-2024-0369
- June 22-25, 2025 – MARC Conference
- July 14-25 – Evidentiary hearing in ER-2024-0261

Therefore, the Commission is directing the parties to submit a new proposed procedural schedule considering the above Commission conflicts.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall submit a new proposed procedural schedule no later than February 13, 2025.
