1 LAW JUDGE HATCHER: Okay, everyone. This
2 is Judge Hatcher. I'm back. Let's go on the record.
3 We do not have a court reporter today, but the
4 conference -- procedural conference is being recorded
5 for potential transcription later. If any parties
6 would like a transcript made, they merely need to file
7 a motion or even just send an e-mail to myself or to
8 Judge Fewell. He is the actual judge assigned to this
9 case. I'm filling in for him as he's away today.

10 I do not see Ryan Dooley in attendance. Is
11 Ryan Dooley on the line?

12 Okay. Hearing nothing, we'll go ahead and
13 run through, for the record, that today is
14 January 25th, 2025. The Commission has set this time
15 for a prehearing conference in file number
16 EC-2025-0093. It is a compliant case with Ryan Dooley
17 as the complainant. This conference is being held via
18 Webex.

19 My name is Charles Hatcher. I'm the
20 regulatory law judge. I'm filling in for Regulatory
21 Law Judge Fewell who is the judge assigned to this
22 case.

23 Again, I'd like to ask, is Ryan Dooley in
24 attendance? Please speak up if you are. And if
25 you're on a phone, that is star, six to unmute.

1 All right. Hearing none, I'll let the
2 record reflect that the procedural conference was
3 started at 10:00 a.m., and we waited. It is now 10:17
4 for the attendance of Mr. Dooley. He has not shown,
5 and we have called him several times. Called his name
6 to see if he is on the line. Got no response.

7 So with that, let's go ahead and move to
8 adjourn our procedural conference. Before I formally
9 adjourn and shut this Webex down, were there any
10 issues or questions by the -- the counsel or parties

3 was forgetting something. Thank you, Mr. Johnson.

4 Let's go ahead and do our entries of
5 appearance for the counsel representing the parties
6 that are here. I will again go ahead and call Ryan
7 Dooley. Ryan Dooley, please speak up.

8 Hearing none, let's go to Ameren Missouri.

9 MS. JOHNSON: Carla Johnson and Jennifer
10 Hernandez on behalf of Ameren.

11 LAW JUDGE HATCHER: Thank you, Ms. Johnson.
12 And for Staff Counsel's Office.

13 MS. HANSEN: Andrea Hansen entering on
14 behalf of Staff Counsel's Office.

15 LAW JUDGE HATCHER: Thank you, Ms. Hansen.

16 And Office of Public Counsel, I did not
17 expect anyone from the Public Counsel Office to be
18 here. That is excellent. Any other matters before I
19 do go ahead and adjourn?

20 Okay. Hearing none, thank you all for
21 attendance. I will refer this back to Judge Fewell,
22 and he will take whatever next steps are appropriate.
23 Appreciate you all being here. Thank you for your
24 time.
