ORDER SETTING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS

Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri submitted tariff sheets on September 30, 2024, to produce a net increase in its gas base rates of approximately \$39.6 million. On December 23, 2024, the parties filed a Filing of Local Public Hearing Notice in which they suggested three in-person and two virtual local public hearings.

The Commission will set local public hearings as suggested by the parties.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make an informal presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the beginning of each local public hearing. Comments to the Commission from the public will begin at the conclusion of the question and answer session.

2. Ameren Missouri, Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer sessions. Any other party may also choose to have a representative present.

3. Any person may participate at any of the hearings, but are encouraged to attend the hearing closest to their service area for the most relevant information.

Comments at each hearing may be limited to three minutes per person.

10. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the county commission for each county in Ameren Missouri's service areas.

11. No later than February 11, 2025, Staff shall file proposed language to be included in the notice of the local public hearings to be provided by Ameren Missouri to its customers.

12. On April 11, 2025, Ameren Missouri shall provide additional notice of the local public hearings via text message and/or email to customers signed up to receive electronic messages from Ameren Missouri.

13. This order shall be effective when issued.
