MOTION TO INVITE COMMENTS
REGARDING COSTS OF COMPLIANCE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and for its *Motion to Invite Comments Regarding the Costs of Compliance*, respectfully states:

1. The Commission must review the actual public cost of the rule being implemented, pursuant to Section 536.200.3, of the Revised Statutes of Missouri (“RSMo,”) (Cum. Supp. 2023). That statute requires a review of actual public costs of implementation of the rule incurred during the first full fiscal year after implementation of the rule. The end of the State of Missouri’s fiscal year (“FY”) 2025 is June 30, 2025.

2. The rule 20 CSR 4240-13.075 that was the subject of this rulemaking has been published in the Missouri Code of State Regulations and became effective on December 30, 2023.

3. The Commission ordered Staff to review the fiscal cost as required by Section 536.200.3, RSMo, and file a report of its findings or a statement as to when it expects to file its review no later than August 29, 2025.

4. As part of that review, it would be helpful to gather information from interested stakeholders about whether the estimated costs to comply with the rules set out in the fiscal notes have proved to be accurate.

WHEREFORE, Staff prays that the Commission will, by order or notice, invite interested stakeholders to file comments in this docket no later than June 16, 2025, as to the actual cost of the implementation of the rule.
