**ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE  
AND DIRECTING STATUS REPORT**

On March 4, 2022, Evergy Missouri West and Evergy Missouri Metro (Evergy) filed a motion to immediately suspend the December 6, 2021 procedural schedule in this case to accommodate the parties' ongoing settlement discussions. Evergy stated that all other parties have been apprised of its motion, and that no party objects. The Commission finds Evergy's request to be reasonable.

The Commission will grant Evergy's request and direct Evergy to file a status report no later than April 1, 2022.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The procedural schedule issued on December 6, 2021, is suspended, pending settlement negotiations between the parties.
2. The evidentiary hearing scheduled for April 5 and 6, 2022, is removed from the Commission's calendar.

3. Evergy will file a status report apprising the Commission whether settlement discussions are likely to produce a settlement agreement no later than April 1, 2022.

4. This Order shall be effective when issued.
