ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF CORRECTED COMPLIANCE REPORT

On April 14, 2022, The Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri) filed its renewable energy standard compliance report for 2021, regarding its compliance in 2021 (Report), and its renewable energy standard compliance plan for 2022 through 2024 (Plan). These filings are required by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8).

The Commission issued its order directing notice of filing on April 15, and granted an application to intervene by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Division of Energy (Division of Energy) on May 24.

The Commission's rule requires the Staff of the Commission to review the utility's Report and Plan and to file a report about its review within 45 days. It also allows other stakeholders 45 days to file a response to the Report and Plan.¹ Staff requested, and the Commission granted, a 45-day extension to file its report, making Staff's report and any other responses due on July 15.

On July 5, Ameren Missouri filed a request to submit a corrected Report, with a corrected Report attached. The Commission granted Ameren Missouri's request on July 6.

Staff filed its report and memorandum on Ameren Missouri's Report and Plan on July 15, indicating that Ameren Missouri's Plan meets the requirements for RES compliance plans set forth in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(B)1.A-G. Additionally, Staff's report indicates that Staff has not identified any deficiencies in Ameren Missouri's Report under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(A)1-3. However, on pages 2 and 3 of its report, Staff notes an error in Ameren Missouri's reporting of its Missouri jurisdictional revenue in its corrected Report. Specifically, Ameren Missouri reported its total jurisdictional revenue as \$3,232,295,619 in the Report, but lists the same as \$2,861,718,816 in its Missouri jurisdictional annual report. Neither Public Counsel, nor any other interested filed a comment regarding Ameren Missouri's Report or Plan. Ameren Missouri did not respond to Staff's report.

An accurate report of the company's total jurisdictional revenue from the total retail electric sales to Missouri customers as measured at the customers meters is required under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(A)1B. The Commission will order Ameren Missouri to revise its Report to show the correct jurisdictional revenue, consistent with the requirements outlined on page 2 and 3 of Staff's Memorandum of July 15, 2022, to comply with the Commission Rule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri shall file its corrected 2021 renewable energy standard compliance report to show the correct total jurisdictional revenue from the total retail electric sales to Missouri customers as measured at the customers' meters no later than

August 8, 2022.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
