AMEREN MISSOURI RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "Company") and, in response to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), states as follows:

1. On January 10, 2025, Ameren Missouri filed an application for permission to issue and sell additional long-term indebtedness.
2. On January 13, 2025, the Commission ordered Staff to file its Recommendation or a request for an extension of time no later than January 27, 2025. Staff made a timely request for an extension and the Commission granted Staff's request on January 27, 2025. On February 4, 2025, the Staff of the Commission ("Staff") filed its recommendation, which included seven conditions upon which its recommendation to approve was conditioned.
3. Ameren Missouri files this response to inform the Commission that it does not object to the Staff's recommended conditions.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri requests that the Commission issue an Order approving Ameren Missouri's application, including the conditions proposed by Staff.
