KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed a tariff revision on September 22, 2014, to amend its Residential Lighting and Appliance Program to remove two measures from the "Eligible Lighting and Appliance Measures" section of the tariff. The tariff revision carries an October 22 effective date, but GMO has filed a motion for expedited treatment asking the Commission to approve the tariff revision to take effect on October 2.

If the Commission is to approve GMO's tariff revision to be effective on October 2, it will need to act at its October 1 agenda meeting. Therefore, the Commission will establish a shortened time for the filing of responses to GMO's motion.
