CORRECTED ORDER GIVING NOTICE AND SETTING A DEADLINE TO INTERVENE

Issue Date: March 4, 2025 Effective Date: March 4, 2025

The order issued on February 27, 2025, contained an incorrect statement concerning a "net" increase in annual electric revenues. Those references have been deleted. The Commission will reissue this notice and expand the intervention period.

On February 26, 2025, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty filed tariff sheets designed to increase its annual electric revenues by a total of approximately \$152 million. The requested increase represents a 29.64% increase over current base rate electric service revenues.¹

This notice follows after Liberty determined there was an error in the tariff sheets it filed on November 6, 2024, to which the Commission previously gave notice and set an intervention period. Due to the change in the requested increase to annual electric

revenues, the Commission is re-issuing notice and re-opening the time for intervention.

Parties already granted intervention need not reapply for intervention.²

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the county commission of each county within the service area of The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty.
- 2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing the service area of The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty and to the news media as appropriate.
- 3. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than March 25, 2025, with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission or in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System.
 - 4. This order shall be effective when issued.
