**ORDER MODIFYING HEARING SCHEDULE AND SETTING
ON-THE-RECORD PRESENTATION OF SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

On February 14, 2020, the Staff of the Commission (Staff), on behalf of all the parties, filed a status report and motion to amend the hearing schedule. Staff stated that the parties expect to file a settlement agreement commemorating all the settled issues during the week of February 24, 2020. In light of this agreement, the parties request that the Commission delay the start of the scheduled hearing until March 9, 2020. The parties state that the remaining issues will likely take four days to present. The parties also suggest that if the Commission would like to have a presentation of the settlement agreement, the presentation be scheduled in the week prior to the beginning of the hearing.

The Commission has considered the requests and determines that it will grant the requested delay. The Commission will also schedule an on-the-record presentation during the week prior to the new scheduled hearing start as set out below. The Commission will generally adopt the parties' proposed hearing schedule with the caveat that dates for specific witnesses may change if the presentation of evidence takes more or less time than anticipated. The Commission will alter the procedural schedule as set out below.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties' request to amend the hearing schedule is granted.
2. The hearing is set for **March 9-13, 2020** beginning at **10:00 a.m.** on the first day. The hearing will be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. The Commission will hold an on-the-record presentation regarding the settlement agreement reached on issues in this case on **March 4, 2020** beginning at **11:00 a.m.** The presentation will be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
