It was brought to my attention that Ameren/ATXI stated that they received the assessment roll from the Worth County Assessor’s Office the spring of 2024.

I was the Assessor during that time and have no recollection of that transaction. I found that date odd as most sales are done after the assessment books are rolled over (July), and the data is generally made available for sale after it has been certified (Sep/Oct/Nov).

View the attached treasurer’s report. As you can see it shows no deposits for assessment rolls during the time in question. Second, I wrote the local sunshine law policy for the office and do not recall waiving any associated fees. Finally, the data is only provided electronically via email, and the email had no record sending that data to Ameren/ATXI.
