## **ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE**

On November 29, 2020, The Empire District Electric Company applied for approval of a portfolio of transportation electrification pilot programs and accounting treatment pursuant to Section 393.140(8) RSMo. The Commission issued an order directing notice and setting a deadline of December 30, 2020, for requests to intervene.

Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri, and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group filed applications to intervene. Ten days have elapsed, and no party has objected to the applications to intervene.<sup>1</sup> The applications satisfy the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075 and intervention will be granted.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applications to intervene filed by Renew Missouri and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group are granted.
