ORDER MODIFYING THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND ACCEPTING LATE FILED TESTIMONY AND AFFIDAVITS

Effective Date: March 10, 2025

On February 27, 2025, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion to modify the procedural schedule on behalf of the parties. That motion represented that the parties had reached an agreement resolving all revenue requirement issues. The Commission granted the motion allowing additional time for the parties to file an issues list and position statements. On March 4, 2025, Staff filed an issues list on behalf of the parties and proposed that the evidentiary hearing be reduced to two days, March 18-19 of 2025, for the Commission to hear four remaining unresolved issues.

Accordingly, the Commission will modify the procedural schedule to cancel the first day of the evidentiary hearing, March 17, 2025. The parties have not yet filed a stipulation and agreement concerning revenue requirement issues and the Commission is reluctant to cancel the remainder of the evidentiary hearing without having an opportunity to evaluate whether the parties' agreement is acceptable. Accordingly, the Commission will not cancel evidentiary hearing dates after March 19, 2025, at this time.

On December 4, 2024, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri filed a *Motion for Leave to Late File the Direct Testimony of Michael Murry*, and on January 23, 2025, Renew Missouri filed a *Motion to Late File Affidavit of Dana Gray*. No objections were received and the Commission will grant Renew Missouri's motions.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The start date of the evidentiary hearing is delayed until March 18, 2025, at 9:00 a.m.
2. Renew Missouri's motions to accept the late filed testimony of Michael Murry and the late filed affidavit of Dana Gray are granted.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
