On February 24, 2021, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro filed an application requesting the Commission approve a transportation electrification pilot program.

Applications to intervene in this case were filed by Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, and Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG).

More than 10 days have passed since the applicants named above applied to intervene; no party has objected to the intervention of Renew Missouri, Ameren Missouri, or MECG.

The Commission will grant the applications to intervene based on a determination that intervention will serve the public interest, as provided by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Applications to intervene filed by Renew Missouri, Ameren Missouri, and MECG are granted.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
