ORDER SUSPENDING REMAINDER OF EVIDENTIARY HEARING

The evidentiary hearing in this matter is currently scheduled to continue through March 12, 2025.

On March 10, 2025, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC), on behalf of itself and the other parties in this matter,¹ filed a *Motion to Suspend Evidentiary Hearing and Motion for Expedited Treatment*. MAWC states that it, Staff, and OPC have agreed in principle to the terms of a settlement on the cost of service/revenue requirement and that there is no known objection to the terms of the settlement by the other parties. MAWC indicates that settlement discussions continue on remaining issues that have already been tried during the evidentiary hearing.

The Commission will grant the motion and suspend the remainder of the evidentiary hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The remainder of the evidentiary hearing in this matter is suspended until further order of the Commission.

2. No later than March 17, 2025, the parties shall file a stipulation and agreement on the issue of cost of service/revenue requirement and any other issues on which there is agreement not included in previously-filed partial stipulations and agreements. In lieu of a stipulation and agreement, the parties may file a status report.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
