## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On February 24, 2021, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro filed an application requesting the Commission approve a transportation electrification pilot program.

On March 15, 2021, the Commission granted applications to intervene in this case filed by Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, and Midwest Energy Consumers Group. On March 23, 2021, the Commission granted applications to intervene filed by The Empire District Electric Company, Natural Resources Defense Council and Spire Missouri, Inc.

Applications to intervene have also been filed by ChargePoint, Inc. and Sierra Club.

More than 10 days have passed since the applicants named above applied to intervene; no party has objected to the intervention of ChargePoint and Sierra Club.

The Commission will grant the applications to intervene based on a determination that intervention will serve the public interest, as provided by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3).
