The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Application to Intervene of the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers* ("motion").¹ The Commission received no response to the motion. In the motion, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers ("MIEC") states that it is a Missouri corporation, represents large industrial customers of the applicant, and opposes the application. Those allegations show an interest in this action different from the general public, and which the Commission's final order may adversely affect. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.²

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Application to Intervene of the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers* is granted.
