**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE**

On June 24, 2014, Midwest Energy Consumers' Group ("MECG") filed a timely motion to intervene in the above-captioned matter. MECG represents large, industrial consumers of electric energy in the state of Missouri. MECG has an interest in Kansas City Power & Light Company's application for Construction Accounting that is different from that of the general public. Its interests may be adversely impacted by a final order in the file.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3) authorizes the Commission to grant an application to intervene if the party has an interest different from that of the general public that may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No party objected to MECG's motion to intervene.

Upon review of the unopposed application, the Commission finds MECG meets the standard set forth in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3). Therefore, the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Midwest Energy Consumers' Group's *Application to Intervene* is granted.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
