On October 16, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri applied for an accounting authority order permitting it to track and defer in regulatory assets all incremental costs and other financial impacts including lost revenues related to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Commission issued an order directing notice, and setting a deadline of November 10, 2020, for requests to intervene.

Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri and the Consumers Council of Missouri filed applications to intervene. Ten days have elapsed, and no party has objected to the application to intervene.¹ The application satisfies the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075 and interventions will be granted.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applications to intervene filed by Renew Missouri and the Consumers Council of Missouri are granted.

¹ Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(13) provides that parties shall be allowed ten days from the date of filing in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.
