**COMES NOW** Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc., (“Confluence Rivers” or “Company”) and for its *Notice of Closing As To Shelton Estates* respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On December 15, 2021, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* (“*Order*”) in these cases. The Order granted Certificates of Convenience and Necessity for the various water and sewer assets of The Missing Well, Spring Branch, Shelton Estates, Clemstone, Prairie Heights, and Cedar Green Land Acquisitions, LLC, and required Confluence Rivers to notify the Commission of closing on any of the assets in these cases. The only assets that had not been previously closed on by Confluence Rivers were the sewer assets of Shelton Estates.


