2024 YEARLY REPORT

COMES NOW The Empire District Gas Company d/b/a Liberty (“EDG” or the “Company”), and respectfully provides its 2024 Yearly Report to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) pursuant to the Commission’s *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement, Granting Variance, and Granting Waiver* (“Approval Order”) issued in the above-captioned matter on August 2, 2023 and effective August 12, 2023:

1. On page 3 of the Approval Order, the requirements for the contents of a yearly report to be filed by EDG is set out as follows:

- i. number of remaining meters required to be tested to complete catch-up program;
- ii. summary of test results by Group as defined by in the Application appendix C (as amended);
- iii. description of any impacts to annual meter testing target, including but not limited to supply-chain issues, internal constraints, and third-party testing;
- iv. number of letters sent to customers offering courtesy inspections; and,
- v. number of courtesy inspections completed.

2. Accordingly, for this 2024 Yearly Report, EDG states as follows:

- i. the number of remaining meters required to be tested to complete catch-up program is 1,761;

- ii. a summary of test results by Group is shown in Attachment 1, 2024 Catchup meter exchange test results 3-31-25.xlsx;
- iii. description of any impacts to annual meter testing target, including but not limited to supply-chain issues, internal constraints, and third-party testing: none to note for 2024;
- iv. the number of letters sent to customers offering courtesy inspections is 605; and
- v. the number of courtesy inspections completed is 3.
