On March 31, 2025,¹ the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a *Motion Requesting*

Local Public Hearings and for Expedited Treatment, requesting local public hearings on

the application of Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) be held on April 22

and 23 and that an order be issued by the Commission by April 4.

On April 1, the Commission issued an order setting April 3, 10:00 a.m., as the deadline for parties to Staff's request. No parties filed responses.

The Commission will set local public hearings as requested by Staff and will instruct persons on how to submit written comments.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. An in-person local public hearing shall be held at the Milan Community

Center, 205 North Market Street, Milan, Missouri to begin at 6 p.m. on April 22, 2025.

2. A virtual local public hearing shall be held via the internet-based video and teleconferencing service, WebEx, to begin at **12:00 p.m.** on **April 23, 2025**.

a. To attend the virtual local public hearing **by telephone**, at the time of the hearing call toll free 1-650-479-3207, listen to the prompt and enter the meeting number/access code 2867 411 6123, followed by # (pound/hashtag symbol). If prompted for a password, enter 0087.

b. To attend a virtual local public hearing **by video/internet** visit the website at <u>www.webex.com</u> or download the Cisco WebEx Meetings application. At hearing time, enter the meeting number/access code 2867 411 6123 and password 0087.

3. Each local public hearing shall begin with an informal presentation and question-and-answer session conducted by the Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department. Formal public comments to the Commission will begin immediately following the conclusion of the question-and-answer session.

4. Any person who needs an accommodation to participate in the hearing should call the Public Service Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 before the hearing.

5. Written comments may be submitted to the Commission by mailing the comment to the Missouri Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, MO 65102, or by using the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) at https://psc.mo.gov/General/Submit_Comments. When submitting comments please reference File No. EA-2025-0087.

6. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commissions for Adair, Daviess, DeKalb, Grundy, Knox, Lewis, Macon, Marion, Randolph, and Sullivan Counties and to the news media serving those counties.

7. ATXI shall draft a notice of the local public hearings and provide that notice to Staff for approval. Once approved, ATXI shall provide that notice to property owners within the notification corridor for ATXI's proposed route, as shown in Appendices E, F,

and G to its application – that is, to the property owners listed in the Confidential attachments to Appendix D of its application. Notice shall be sent via the United States Postal Service and shall be postmarked no later than April 8, 2025.

8. This order shall be effective when issued.
