## Primary Narrative By Blake Bullard

On Thursday, January 11, 2024 at approximately 11:55 am, Joseph Wissman reported a delayed theft. Mr. Wissman reported the theft occurred at [REDACTED].

I, Deputy Bullard, arrived on scene and met with Mr. Wissman outside of his residence. Mr. Wissman stated that on Wednesday, December 27, 2023 he was alerted via email that multiple packages he had ordered arrived at this residence. Mr. Wissman went on to state when he went to look for them they were missing. Mr. Wissman also stated today he noticed he was missing multiple items out of his shop. Mr. Wissman went on to state upon further investigation he was missing more items outside near the telephone pole that Ameren had just put on his property. Mr. Wissman stated that he has been in "an on going battle" with Ameren since the end of November 2023. Mr. Wissman went on to state that on multiple occasions he has seen lights on his property late at night, but did not bother to investigate or call law enforcement. Mr. Wissman stated that the Ameren employees have been coming on his property at all points in time of the day and he believes they are responsible for all of the thefts on the property.

Mr. Wissman was adamant he wanted a report for insurance purposes. I then collected photographs and an itemized list of the missing property with approximate values. Mr. Wissman reported the following items have been stolen:
