## STAFF SECOND REPORT AND PROPOSED WORKSHOP SCHEDULES

Comes now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") through the Office of the Staff Counsel and files its Second Staff Report And Proposed Workshop Schedules in response to the January 28, 2010 Order Directing Filing Of Proposed Schedule of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") relating to the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 ("PURPA") Section 111(d)(16) - (19) standards, as established by Sections 532 and 1307 of the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 ("EISA"). Also, the Staff notes that

the Commission established File No. EW-2010-0187<sup>1</sup> on December 21, 2009 and issued an Order Opening Case To Investigate Implementation Of Various Demand-Side Programs on January 6, 2010 to investigate how the Commission may achieve its new responsibilities under the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act ("MEEIA," "Senate Bill No. 376," "SB 376," or Section 393.1075 RSMo. Cum. Supp. 2009), within the background of Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") policies that eliminate barriers to demand response and that direct the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. ("MISO") and the Southwest Power Pool, Inc. ("SPP") to accommodate state policy regarding retail customer demand-side activity. The Staff submits as its Second Staff Report And Proposed Workshop Schedules the following:

1. On February 22, 2010, a workshop involving File Nos. EW-2009-0290, EW-2009-0291, and EW-2009-0292 and File No. EW-2010-0187 was held in the Ballroom of the Governor Office Building commencing at 10:00 a.m. The purpose of the February 22, 2010 workshop was to discuss and schedule workshops consistent with the Commission's January 13, 2010 Procedural Order in File Nos. EW-2009-0290, EW-2009-0291, and EW-2009-0292.

2. At the workshop on February 22, 2010 the participants agreed to three tracks:

- A track for the currently-underway revision of Chapter 22 Electric Utility Resource Planning rules, which covers File Nos. EW-2009-0290 (integrated resource planning standard) and EW-2009-0412;
- A track and issues for the workshops for energy efficiency investment / demand-side programs, which covers SB 376 / MEEIA / Section 393.1075 and File Nos. EW-2009-0291 and EW-2010-0187, with initial workshops scheduled for April 14, May 17 18 (a.m. only), and June 11, 2010:

Wherefore the Staff submits the instant Staff Second Report And Proposed Workshop Schedules in compliance with the Commission's January 28, 2010 Order Directing Filing Of Proposed Schedule.
