Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services, LLC (the "Company") hereby supplements its March 19, 2025 Notification regarding the change of the Company's legal name from "Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services, Inc." to "Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services, LLC." On April 3, 2025, Staff filed a Notice in the Docket observing that the Company had not submitted a tariff filing regarding the Company's Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 6. On April 3, 2025, the Commission issued an Order requiring the Company file either a tariff filing that replaces existing tariff Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 6 in its entirety or a one-page adoption notice of Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 6. As explained below, the Company no longer owns the business that provided services pursuant to Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 6 and has accordingly filed to cancel the Tariff.

On November 30, 2022, the Company concluded a transaction where it sold the assets comprising the Kansas City metropolitan area competitive local exchange carrier business to Everfast Fiber Networks, LLC ("Everfast").¹ On October 6, 2022, in Docket TA-2023-0124, the Commission authorized Everfast to provide telecommunications service in Missouri as a competitive local exchange carrier and as an interexchange carrier.
