Water

Water rates inside the city limits are \$12.50 for the first 1,000 gallons (minimum charge) and \$3.30 per 1,000 gallons thereafter. Locations outside the city limits are charged \$18.75 for the first 1,000 gallons and \$4.95 per 1,000 gallons thereafter.

Sewer

Inside the City Limits: \$10 for 1st 1,000 gal; \$8.00/1,000 gal thereafter. Sewer charges are calculated on your water usage for the month.

Outside the City Limits \$15 for 1st 1,000 gal: \$12.00 /1,000 gal thereafter.

Deposit & Rate Information

The Utility Billing Division is the primary point of contact for water and sewer service provided to Republic utility customers and collection of monies. Each customer must establish water/sewer service in person at City Hall. The service deposit and \$10 set-up fee is required at the time of application for service along with showing proof of proper identification. The City of Republic municipal utility operates under an Identity Theft Prevention Policy which is in compliance with the FTC Red Flags Rule.

Water service is connected by advance notice only and is to be scheduled in person at least one-half day prior to the start of needing service. Water service connections will be done Monday - Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., excluding holidays.

Service Deposit

Deposits are not transferable from one customer to another. The service deposit is applied to the final bill or the customer may request the deposit be applied to their account after the account has been penalty free for twelve consecutive months. Any account that has been disconnected due to non-payment will be subject to the following deposit requirement. This is to be paid prior to reconnection.

Establishing Service

Important Information On Sanitary Sewer Billing:

- Residential users are billed sanitary sewer charges based on metered use during the months of October through March. During the months of April through September, residential users are billed sanitary sewer charges based on the average monthly water usage (rounded off to the nearest hundred gallons) of the previous period of October through March.
- Irrigation meters are billed for water service only and can be installed at the customer's expense for irrigation use outside of the summer sewer average period

Temporary Disconnection

A customer who requests a temporary disconnection of service for other than a repair of a water leak or for longer than a 48-hour period will be assessed a \$25 turn-on charge upon the customer's written notification to the City for re-instatement of service.

Winter Average (WA)

- (a) For existing permanent and temporary services: The WA shall be the average of the billed monthly usages for the most recent and complete billing months November through May, rounded to the closest whole CCF. In determining WA, prorated months, months with less than one complete month of service, months prior to the initiation of service, and months with services discontinued due to non-payment shall not be included in the WA calculation.
- (b) For new permanent and temporary services, without at least one complete billing month among the most recent November through May billing months: Initially, until a Winter Period usage occurs, the WA shall be the highest billed monthly usage, rounded to the closest whole CCF. Once an actual billed monthly usage (not an estimate) is available for a complete November through May billing month, WA shall be the same as defined for existing services, paragraph (a). Temporary services served from permanent service equipment, which may be disconnected during portions of the year, are seasonal services, instead of temporary services, with WA determined by paragraph (c).
- (c) Services which have been temporarily discontinued for more than 24 hours due to a customer's request, and then reconnected prior to twelve months, and which are without at least one complete billing month among the most recent November through May billing months: The WA shall be the average of the most recent and complete November through May billed monthly usages, rounded to the closest whole CCF, setting the usage at zero for each and all months during which any portion of the month service was disconnected. This paragraph (c) is also applicable to seasonal services, and recurrent temporary services, approved by the General Manager without complete usage history during at least one of the most recent November through May billing months.

Outside City Charge

All charges shall be ten percent (10%) more per service outside the corporate limits of the City of Springfield, Missouri.
