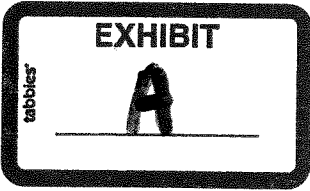

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "Applicant") hereby applies for electrical service, membership in, and agrees to purchase electric energy from SEMO Electric Cooperative (hereinafter called "Cooperative") upon the terms and conditions as herein stated.

The Applicant will, when electric service becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative all the electric energy purchased for use on the premises described above, and will pay therefore monthly at rates to be determined from time-to-time in accordance with the bylaws of the Cooperative; provided, however, that the Cooperative may limit the amount of energy which it shall be required to furnish to the Applicant. The Applicant will pay a monthly minimum for service which does not include any kilowatt hours. Upon purchasing electrical energy, the Applicant will become a member of the Cooperative with rights therein.

The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation and the policies, tariffs, and bylaws as may from time-to-time be adopted by the Cooperative and authorize a deduction of not more than \$5.00 annually from the Cooperative equity as payment for my subscription to the monthly publication "Rural Missouri".

The Applicant will pay the Cooperative a security deposit, if required, which will not earn interest and will be refunded in accordance with the policies of the Cooperative.

The Applicant will cause his premises to be properly wired in accordance with National Electric Safety Code. The Cooperative may refuse to connect, and may disconnect service to any service not meeting the code.

The Applicant agrees to grant right-of-way easements to the Cooperative on Applicant's property as such are needed by the Cooperative to construct, maintain and operate its system as required by laws and regulations governing same.

Applicant also agrees to grant access to Cooperative Meter Readers so that they may read and inspect meters on a monthly basis. Some applicants may be required to read and submit a meter reading each month.

Applicant also agrees that should service be terminated due to failure to pay monthly bill, the Cooperative is not to be held liable for any damages incurred as a result of such termination.

Acceptance of the application by Cooperative shall constitute a contract for electric service between Applicant and Cooperative which shall continue from date of this application until canceled by written notice by either party to the other.
