ORDER SETTING HEARING DATE

Issue Date: April 21, 2025

Effective Date: April 21, 2025

White River Valley Cooperative, Inc. (White River) filed an application on February 19, 2025, pursuant to Section 386.800.3, RSMo, and 20 CSR 4240-20.045, for an order approving designated service boundaries. On February 27, 2025, Staff was ordered to file a recommendation by March 28, 2025. On March 26, 2025, Staff filed a Status Report saying they would not file a recommendation until April 21, 2025. On March 27, 2025, all parties were ordered to file a Procedural Schedule by April 3, 2025.

On April 3, 2025, Staff filed a pleading titled "Motion for Extension" and requested additional time to file a Procedural Schedule. Staff stated no other party objected to the extension and stated they would file a Procedural Schedule by April 8, 2025. On April 8, 2025, Staff Counsel filed a Second Motion for Extension. On April 9, 2024, an order was issued by the Commission to hold a Pre-Hearing Conference on April 10, 2025. On April 10, 2025, a Pre-Hearing Conference was held with counsel for Empire, Staff, and White River participating. After discussion and by agreement, all parties were ordered to submit a Procedural Schedule to the Commission no later than Monday, April 14, 2025. On April 14, 2025, Staff filed a Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule. On April 18, the Commission ordered a procedural schedule to be adopted.

The Commission will order a trial date of July 7, 2025 for a hearing on this matter.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. An evidentiary hearing on this matter will be held on July 7, 2025, beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Hearing Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
