APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

COMES NOW Paul Kazakevicius and and pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.075, applies to intervene in the above-captioned case. For its *Application to Intervene*, Paul Kazakevicius states as follows:

1. Paul Kazakevicius (hereinafter “Landowner”) owns property east and west of 26264 MO-46, Grant City, MO 64456 Therefore, Ameren’s request to build a transmission line Near my property directly affects Landowner and his/her interests.

2. As a Landowner, my interests in this case are different than those of the general public because I have considered building a residence on my property and am concerned about the health hazards of being located so close to the proposed route of these lines.

3. If the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) does not allow me to intervene in this case, I am concerned that the final order may adversely affect me because there I would have no voice in direct impacts to me. However, permitting my intervention does benefit the public because the public benefits whenever all voices, and differing perspectives are heard and considered in the matter. No one situation is exactly the same and we all don’t share the same concerns in this matter.

4. Regarding the issues that other parties have highlighted in the case so far I fully support the construction of transmission lines, but I do not support these lines being built within 1000 feet of an existing or planned residence. Yes, it might be more expensive to accommodate the route, but considering the health of families is a small price to pay.

5. Therefore, I am requesting that the Commission grant my application to intervene in this case.

WHEREFORE, I, Paul Kazakevicius respectfully request the Commission grant this *Application to Intervene*, along with any further relief the Commission deems proper.
