RE: T-Mobile's Acquisition and Seamless Transition of UScellular's Customers

## Dear Secretary Dippell:

As you may be aware, T-Mobile US, Inc. ("T-Mobile") is in the process of completing an acquisition of United States Cellular Corporation's ("UScellular") wireless operations, customers and select spectrum assets (the "Transaction"). The Transaction is currently pending approval from the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), and while T-Mobile cannot predict the timing or outcome of the FCC's proceeding, it believes that approval and consummation of the Transaction could occur by mid-2025.

T-Mobile is the second largest wireless carrier in the United States, serving 130.9 million customers.<sup>2</sup> Through its retail stores, third-party distributors, and websites, T-Mobile offers wireless voice and data services, as well as a wide selection of wireless devices and accessories, to residential and business customers in the United States—including the state of Missouri. After closing of the Transaction, T-Mobile will integrate UScellular's customers and assets into its own network and operations.

In Missouri, T-Mobile, through Assurance Wireless, USA. L.P. ("Assurance Wireless"), is an authorized Lifeline-only provider. T-Mobile intends to facilitate a seamless transition of UScellular Lifeline customers at closing of the Transaction. No UScellular Lifeline customer will be impacted by the transition of assets from UScellular to T-Mobile – UScellular's Lifeline customers will not need to take any action to retain their discount as they will continue on their current plans.

After closing of the Transaction, Assurance Wireless plans to contact each of these customers regarding their options going forward, including the option to migrate to Assurance Wireless. Lifeline customers will have the option to remain on their current UScellular Lifeline plan, transition to an Assurance Wireless plan, or move to another provider. T-Mobile notes that it does have eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") status in Missouri. Once the transaction is complete, T-Mobile intends to seek expanded ETC designation from the Commission to encompass UScellular's customer footprint to the extent necessary. T-Mobile urges the Commission to consider waiving any rules that would restrict Assurance from being designated throughout the state, which would allow Assurance Wireless to serve as many Lifeline customers as possible.

T-Mobile looks forward to working with UScellular customers.
