Dear Hon. Dippell:

Pursuant to the December 8, 2022 *Order Approving Settlement* issued in Docket No. EA-2022-0234 ("Order"), NextEra Energy Transmission Southwest, LLC ("NEET Southwest") hereby submits its quarterly update on the construction progress of the NEET Southwest Wolf Creek-Blackberry 345 kV Transmission Project that spans Barton and Jasper counties in Missouri, as well as five counties in Kansas ("Project").

GENERAL OVERVIEW

NEET Southwest has continued to advance the development of the Project in the first quarter of 2025. NEET Southwest has completed land acquisition activities, all agreements with affected counties have been completed, and construction activities are ongoing along the approved route in Kansas and Missouri. All tree clearing activities are complete. NEET Southwest's primary efforts in the first quarter of 2025 have included:

- NEET Southwest is continuing with construction progress along the route in Kansas and Missouri.
- Interconnection with AECI is complete.
- Final reviews are complete on the joint operation agreement with Evergy and Associated Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("AECI"). NEET Southwest expects to sign the agreement in May.

PROJECT DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

NEET Southwest continues to work towards the In-Service date of July 15, 2025. NEET Southwest continues to utilize an experienced team made up of internal and external subject matter experts to develop and execute the Project.

CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS UPDATE

NEET Southwest has completed all tree clearing required for the Project. NEET Southwest continues the installation of poles (currently there are ~526 poles out of 535 installed), and the Project is also over halfway complete with the installation of conductor.

REGULATORY UPDATE

FERC

On October 29, 2024, SPP filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC"), on behalf and at the request of NEET Southwest, revisions to the SPP Tariff to incorporate NEET Southwest's Zonal Annual Transmission Revenue Requirement within the Evergy Zone (identified in the Tariff as Zone 14) (FERC Docket No. ER25-252-000).

Southwest Power Pool

NEET Southwest has signed a Transmission Interconnection Agreement with AECI and SPP for interconnection of the Project to the Blackberry Substation in Missouri. NEET Southwest is finalizing the Transmission Interconnection Agreement with Evergy, and the agreement has already been reviewed by SPP and is expected to be signed in May 2025.

Agreements with Missouri Jurisdictional Public Utilities

NEET Southwest has executed a crossing agreement with Barton County Cooperative and, as stated above, has executed a Transmission Interconnection Agreement with AECI and is finalizing a joint operation agreement with AECI.

LAND UPDATE AND LANDOWNER COMMUNICATIONS

Easements Obtained

NEET Southwest has obtained 100% of the easements needed for the Project.

COUNTY AGREEMENTS AND OUTREACH

NEET Southwest has executed Road Use Agreements with Jasper and Barton County in Missouri.

AFFILIATE CONTRACTS

NEET Southwest has not entered any new affiliate contracts related to operations, maintenance, and reliability.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

NEET Southwest has entered into a contract with Southeast Power Corp. ("Southeast") to provide emergency response services once the Project is operational. NEET Southwest will provide a copy of its contract with Southeast to the Commission upon project completion, consistent with the Order.
