Dear Sir or Madam:

Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI), in collaboration with Ameren Illinois (AIC) and Citizens Electric Corporation, recognize the importance of keeping landowners and stakeholders informed about projects that will affect them. You are receiving this letter because public records show that you own property along or near the route/s of new transmission lines that ATXI is proposing to develop.

Specifically, those records indicate that you own property along or near the proposed route of the Grand Tower Crossing Project. This Project includes the construction of a new, approximately 4-mile, 138 kV transmission line to connect Citizens Electric's existing Wittenberg substation in Perry County, Missouri across the Mississippi River to a new Jenkins substation near Ameren Illinois' existing Grand Tower substation in Jackson County, Illinois. As part of the Project, Ameren Illinois' Grand Tower substation will be retired. A Proposed Route map and map of your parcel/s along the Proposed Route are attached for your review.

In the coming days, ATXI will submit an application to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Mo PSC) in Docket No. EA-2025-0222 for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity and other necessary approvals for the Grand Tower Crossing Project. The expected timing for the Mo PSC decision is Spring 2026.

If approved by the Mo PSC, easement negotiations will begin with affected landowners in Spring 2026 with construction anticipated to start in late 2027. Our goal is to have this new line in service and providing benefits to the local community by the end of 2028.
