ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On May 1, 2025, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo. The CCN would authorize ATXI to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage an approximately four-mile 138 kV transmission line and associated facilities in Perry County, Missouri.

The Commission will provide notice of the application to the general public and interested parties, set a deadline for intervention requests, and direct the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to provide a recommendation regarding ATXI's application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Perry County, Missouri.
2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Perry County, Missouri.

3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than May 16, 2025. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) or with the Secretary of the Commission.

4. Staff shall file a recommendation regarding ATXI's application, or a request for additional time in which to file a recommendation, no later than July 31, 2025.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
