## **ORDER CLOSING CASE**

On September 29, 2000, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Motion to Establish Docket. Staff stated that a natural gas flash fire occurred in an excavation in front of 1426 W. 50th Terrace, in Kansas City, Missouri, at approximately 4:25 p.m., Tuesday, August 8, 2000, and that two contractor workers were injured in the fire. Staff further stated that it had initiated a formal investigation into the incident.

On February 7, 2001, Staff filed its incident report in which it recommended that Missouri Gas Energy (MGE) review and revise as necessary its requirements and training on the use of personal protective equipment, especially when gas may accidentally be released. Staff also recommended the practical elimination of all potential ignition sources in and around an excavation where there is a possibility of an accidental release.

On March 8, 2001, MGE filed its response in which it stated that it intends to implement, or continue to implement, the recommendations in the incident report. MGE stated that its existing requirements and training meet Staff's recommendations, and that it has taken steps to emphasize the importance of following safety procedures. Staff did not reply to MGE's response.

Since MGE has implemented the Staff recommendations, there is no need for further Commission action concerning this incident and this case may be closed.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That this order shall become effective on March 30, 2001.
- 2. That this case may be closed on March 31, 2001.
