MISSOURI GAS ENERGY'S APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

Comes now Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company ("MGE") and for this application to intervene pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075 respectfully states the following:

- 1. MGE is an operating division of Southern Union Company which is duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Delaware, and conducts business under the name of Missouri Gas Energy (the relevant MGE documentation has previously been provided to the Commission in Case No. GM-94-40, and is incorporated herein by this reference). MGE is a "gas corporation" and "public utility" as those terms re defined in Chapter 386 RSMo Supp. 1999 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission as provided by law. MGE provides natural gas service to approximately 484,000 customers in its service area, which is located primarily in portions of western and west-central Missouri, with its largest metropolitan service area being in Kansas City, Missouri. The address of its principal office is 3420 Broadway, Kansas City, Missouri 64111-2404, (816)360-5755, fax (816)360-5536.
- 2. This case was established by order of the Commission dated November 9, 2000, in response to the Commission Staff's request. The Staff requested that this case be established for the purpose of conducting an investigation into certain allegations, made by anonymous letter, regarding the operation of the gas supply services department

of Utilicorp United Inc. In particular, the anonymous letter raised issues with respect to the use of financial instruments on natural gas and capacity release practices. Because MGE has made use of financial instruments on natural gas in the past, and may make use of such instruments in the future, and because this case may lead the Commission to make decisions regarding the use of such instruments which may be argued to have precedential effect upon MGE, MGE clearly has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding, which interest is different from that of the general public and which cannot be adequately represented by any other party.

- 3. In its Order Establishing Case and Directing Notice dated November 9, 2000, the Commission provided that any interested person wishing to intervene in this case should file an application to intervene no later than November 29, 2000. MGE is unable to state at this time whether it supports or opposes the relief sought by the Staff. However, given MGE's direct interest in this case as set forth above, which may be adversely affected by a final order in this case, MGE submits that it meets the criteria for intervention set forth in 4 CSR 240-2.075, and, accordingly, this application to intervene should be granted.
