**NOTICE**

Comes now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through its undersigned attorney, and provides the following information to the Commission.

1. On April 22, 2025,<sup>1</sup> Complainant Leah Gay Goessling filed a complaint with the Commission against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. On May 1, Ameren Missouri filed a Request for Mediation. On May 2, the Commission issued its Order Directing Response to Mediation Request. The Commission ordered Complainant to file a response no later than May 9 stating whether she agrees to enter into mediation.

2. On May 16, Complainant contacted the Staff and informed Staff that she had failed to respond to the Commission's Order because she had been hospitalized. She informed Staff that she **does wish and consent** to participate in mediation.
