STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") in the above-captioned matter and for its recommendation states as follows:

- 1. Fidelity Natural Gas, Inc. ("Company") filed a tariff sheet on October 16, 2000, proposed to be effective November 1, 2000. The filing was made to reflect changes in Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment ("PGA") factors for the upcoming winter season.
- 2. Staff has reviewed the proposed tariff sheet, and recommends that it be approved effective November 1, 2000. The recommendation of the Gas Department Tariffs/Rate Design Staff is attached as Attachment A hereto. Staff notes that good cause has been shown pursuant to §393.140 (11) RSMo to permit the tariff to become effective on less than thirty days notice. Staff also recommends that the rates be interim, subject to refund



WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheet.

On October 16, 2000, Fidelity Natural Gas, Inc. (Fidelity or Company) filed a tariff sheet proposed to become effective November 1, 2000. The tariff sheet was filed to reflect scheduled changes in Fidelity's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors as the result of estimated changes in the cost of natural gas for the upcoming winter season. Additionally, this tariff filing reflects a change in the Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factor of Fidelity.

The effect of these changes will increase the firm PGA factor for the 2000-2001 winter season to \$0.3939 per Ccf from the 1999-2000 winter season firm PGA factor of \$0.2901 per Ccf. Fidelity did not file a 1999 summer PGA factor change.

Case No. GR-2001-250, under which this change was filed, was established to track the Company's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 1999-2000 ACA filing. Interim subject to refund status should be maintained pending a final Commission decision in Case No. GR-2001-250.

Because of the short time available to review documentation supporting the ACA factor represented in this filing, the Commission's Procurement Analysis Department (PAD) has requested permission to submit its results and recommendations regarding information included in this ACA filing to the Commission on or before June 1, 2001.

The Gas Department - Tariffs/Rate Design Staff (Staff) has reviewed this filing and has determined that it was calculated in conformance with Fidelity's PGA Clause. Staff is of the opinion that good cause for approval of this tariff sheet with less than thirty days notice is demonstrated by Fidelity's Commission-approved PGA clause allowing for ten (10) business days notice for PGA change filings. Therefore Staff recommends that the following tariff sheet be approved, interim subject to refund:
