MOTION FOR DISMISSAL OF PARTY
ENERGYONE VENTURES, L.P.

COMES NOW Aquila, Inc., (“Aquila”), by and through its undersigned counsel, and respectfully requests that this Commission dismiss EnergyOne Ventures, L.P. (“EnergyOne”) as a named party in this investigatory proceeding, and that EnergyOne be allowed to withdraw from all further participation in same. In support of this Motion, Aquila respectfully states as follows:

1. By Order issued December 9, 2003, the Commission opened a case to investigate the sale or distribution of gas and electricity in Missouri by entities that are not certificated by the Commission. One of the entities that the Commission’s Order purported to make a party to this case was “Energy One Ventures.”

2. Prior to October 1, 2002, EnergyOne was a Delaware limited partnership in which Aquila was the general partner owning a 1% interest and Agricultural Investment, Inc. (a wholly owned subsidiary of Aquila) was the limited partner owning a 99% interest.

3. Effective October 1, 2002, Aquila, on its own behalf and on behalf of its wholly owned subsidiary Agricultural Investments, Inc., sold EnergyOne to Cornerstone Energy, Inc., a Nebraska corporation, (“Cornerstone”) at which time EnergyOne was merged into Cornerstone.


4. As a result of its aforementioned acquisition by Cornerstone, EnergyOne no longer exists as a separate legal entity and is not registered with the Missouri Secretary of State to conduct business in the state of Missouri.

5. Attached hereto is the Affidavit of Tim Hess, who is the Senior Manager, External Affairs - CO/KS for Aquila, attesting to the facts set forth herein.

6. In view of the above stated grounds, Aquila believes that EnergyOne has inadvertently and erroneously been included within the scope and jurisdiction of these proceedings.

WHEREFORE, Aquila, Inc. respectfully requests that EnergyOne Ventures, L.P. be dismissed from the above-captioned proceeding and relieved from all further participation as a party to this matter.




