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Partially. Staff agrees the costs impacted by COVID-19 should be trued-up 1 A. 2 through September 30, 2021. Does Staff agree with Ameren Missouri's adjustment amount? 3 O. No. During a meeting with Staff and Ameren Missouri, an error in Ameren 4 A. Missouri's adjustment amount was identified. It is Staff's understanding that Ameren Missouri 5 will also correct the error in its true-up. After correction of the error, Staff's total adjustment 6 to test year expense should decrease the test year expense by \$** **. 7 8 ALLOCATIONS On pages 9-10 of Ameren Missouri witness Lansford's rebuttal testimony he 9 Q. states that Staff should not have applied the incremental allocation to gas operations to all 10 administrative and general accounts. Does Staff agree? 11 Yes. Staff agrees with the Company's statement. Staff has reflected the correct 12 A. adjustments in its true-up accounting schedules. 13 ADVANCED METERING INFRASTRUCTURE (AMI) SOFTWARE 14 Ameren Missouri witness Laura Moore states on page 4 of her rebuttal testimony 15 Q. that if the deferral of the AMI software costs is not approved in this gas case then the electric 16 rate base would need to increase by the amount that Ameren Missouri allocated to its gas 17 operations in Case No. ER-2021-0240. Does Staff agree? 18 No. The AMI software was installed with the purpose of serving both electric 19 A. and eventually gas customers. Ameren Missouri recognized this and properly allocated part of 20

the AMI software to its gas operations. To allocate all of the costs to the electric operations is

not accurate since part of the AMI software will eventually be used by the gas operations.

Do you agree with witness Moore's statement that Ameren Missouri could have 1 Q. 2 included the gas allocated costs in the gas revenue requirement? No. The AMI software is not used and useful in providing service to the gas 3 A. customers at this point in time, and therefore it should not be included in the revenue 4 5 requirement in the gas rate case, Case No. GR-2021-0241. In witness Moore's rebuttal testimony she states there is a second aspect to the 6 Q. matching principle that "matches costs with benefits so that ratepayers that enjoy the benefits 7 of utility property also bear the costs." After the AMI software costs are completely amortized, 8 is it possible that Ameren Missouri will still be using the software and ratepayers will be 9 10 enjoying the benefits of said software? Yes. It is possible that the software will be fully amortized but continue to be 11 A. used and useful. 12 13 Q. Does this conclude your surrebuttal testimony? 14 Yes. A.
