On August 28, 2007, the Commission issued its Order Dismissing Application.

On September 6, 2007, Aquila, Inc. filed a Request for Rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, provides that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if “in its judgment sufficient reason therefore shall be made to appear.” The Commission finds that Aquila, Inc. has failed to establish sufficient reason to grant its application. The Commission will deny the application.

1. Aquila Inc.’s Request for Rehearing is denied.
