On October 2, 2013, Labadie Environmental Organization (LEO) and Sierra Club filed a motion asking the Commission to grant them leave to submit a data request to Ameren Missouri. The procedural schedule established for this case set a deadline of August 9 for parties to submit data requests, so, in effect, LEO and Sierra Club are asking for a waiver of the provisions of the procedural schedule.

In response to the motion, the Commission directed that any party wishing to respond to LEO and Sierra Club's motion do so no later than October 4. In the only response filed to the motion, Ameren Missouri indicates it does not object to LEO and Sierra Club's motion.

Given the evolution and extension of the procedural schedule for this case, LEO and Sierra Club's request to serve a data request in response to Ameren Missouri's surrebuttal testimony is reasonable. The commission will grant that request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Labadie Environmental Organization and Sierra Club are granted leave to

serve the data request described in their Motion for Leave to Submit a Data Request.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
